Prequalification Criteria:

- Tenderer should have experience in **Operation and Maintenance of Fish Angling Activities for at least one year in the past three years.** Self-Certification duly notarized has to be submitted.
- The tenderer should have minimum turnover of Rs.5.00 lakh per annum and income tax returns filed for the last 2 years are to be produced.
- **Joint venture /consortium of two parties** is acceptable for this package. MOU in Non-Judicial stamp paper to be submitted declaring the consortium and accepting responsibilities and liabilities severally and jointly.
- The tenderers should have local Office at Chennai to ensure satisfactory fulfillment of all contractual obligations.
- The tenderer should be a Individual/ Registered Firm / Agency / Company with due registration.

The TNFDC administration will not be responsible for any postal delay or loss of the form in postal transit.

The successful tenderer has to remit security deposit in the form of ‘Bank Guarantee’ for a sum equivalent to 25% of the contract value and take up the leased out facilities within 15 days of the date of acceptance of the tender.

The Technical Evaluation Committee will assess the ability of the Tenderers/agencies to render the requisite services based on its past record, profile and on such other criteria as it may fix and only those found fit, will be eligible.

The bidders are required to submit EMD and cost of the document along-with the attested copies of valid Registration Certificate, Pan-Card and up-to date GST details along-with the bid documents, failing which the tender shall be declared as non-responsive and thus liable for rejection.

Submission of more than one tender paper by a tenderer for a particular facility work will render the bid liable for rejection.

The tenderer may assess about the nature and quantum of work before quoting their rate.

Tenderer or his authorized representative may be present at the time of opening of the tender, if they so desire.

Late, delayed, incomplete tenders or with insufficient EMD and other documents will be summarily rejected.

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR
OPERATION & MAINTENANCE OF FISH ANGLING FACILITIES
AT CHETPET ECO PARK IN CHENNAI
(FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS)

1. Tender Components:

This TOR document invites tenderers ***for the Operation and Maintenance of Fish Angling Activities in Chetpet Eco Park***. The period of contract would be for a minimum period of three years with 10% increase in the annual lease amount for the subsequent years. Proposed for tendering by the Tamil Nadu Fisheries Development Corporation Limited to increase revenue and proper management.

4. Objectives:

The objectives of the Operation and Maintenance services for Fish Angling facilities are listed below.

- a. The tenderer is required to run the Angling Facilities inside the Chetpet Eco Park on annual lease basis;
- b. Regular upkeep and manage the infrastructure of Fish Angling Activities including tackle room in the lake and the fishing rods and maintenance of enough fish mass in Angling Pond with frequent stocking of seeds in consultation.

5. Scope of Work:

The various maintenance works (but not limited to) for the contractor are listed in the following sections of the report.

- a. The successful tenderer should issue tickets at the rate fixed by the Corporation @ Rs.300/- for adult and Rs.150/- for child for minimum 3 catches of fish (exclusive of GST if any).
- b. The tenderer should maintain and keep the Fish Angling facilities in operational conditions at all times.
- c. The tenderer should employ enough angling guides at all times and when the Fishing is happening atleast one guide at all times. Enough life guards to be engaged for the safety of Anglers and to avoid any accidents.

- d. The tenderer should maintain and keep the tackle room, fishing rods and related equipments for fishing in good condition at all times by carrying out all replacements and repairs.
- e. The tenderer should maintain all accounting and statutory records as required by the TNFDC.
- f. Feeding of fishes in Angling Pond to be carried out as per the schedule and in Co-ordination and advice of park administration.

6. Terms of Reference:

- a. The tenderer should employ trained angling guide and the TNFDC Ltd. reserves the right to ask for a change if needed.
- b. Proper attendance system for the employees deployed by the tenderer to be maintained.
- c. Tenderer should fulfill all statutory requirements like EPF/ESI etc. as regards to the employees employed by him.
- d. The quote includes repairs and replacement of all tools, fishing rod, needle and provision of fish food etc. and other essential accessories normally required for the task. No separate payment will be made for the same. The Fish Angling Facilities has to be repaired then and there if required by the tenderer at his own cost.
- e. The quote is deemed to include leave relief of deployed personnel.
- f. The working hours of park will be 5.00 am to 8.30 pm. Fish Angling Activities will be evolved in consultation with the park manager likely from 9.00 am to 6.00 pm.
- g. Should employ a guide who will be the in-charge for all activities related to Fish Angling Facilities and who will report to the park's Manager daily.
- h. The tenderer is solely responsible for any mishap, injury, accident caused to public while utilizing the fishing rods and connected equipment's for fishing. The TNFDC Ltd. shall not be responsible for such incidents.
- i. The tenderer shall take insurance coverage under public liability clause during the period of 3 years operation.
- j. The tenderer shall maintain the equipments in proper condition and should furnish a schedule of preventive maintenance for lease equipments such as fishing rod, needle, etc.

- k. The tenderer should operate the Fish Angling Facilities on continuous basis throughout the tender period.
- l. The tenderer should not involved in no unlawful activities like betting, gambling, etc. inside the area of Angling Pond.
- m. Anti Government activities shall not be allowed inside the premises / place allotted to them.
- n. On the expiry of the contract/Tender period, the tenderer shall handover all articles which were entrusted in good conditions.
- o. The quoted amount i.e. the lease amount payable to TNFDC Ltd., will be for annual basis excluding all taxes and charges.
- p. Notice period for termination from either side is 90 (ninety) days, after a minimum of 9 (nine) months operation.
- q. The tenderer should employ atleast 1 No. of staff / guide during the Operation and Maintenance of Fish Angling Facilities.
- r. No modifications are permitted to the infrastructural facilities provided, by the tenderer without permission of the Park Administration.
- s. The tenderer should pay periodical common maintenance cost incurred by the Park Administration towards wages for security service, housekeeping, common repairs and maintenance etc., @ 25% of the annual lease amount or as decided by the competent authority based on actual.

7. Period of Contract:

The period of contract for operation and maintenance of Fish Angling Facilities would be three years with 10% increase in the annual lease amount for the subsequent 2nd & 3rd years.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF TENDER

1. All tenders must be addressed to the Managing Director, TNFDC Ltd., Integrated Office Complex for Animal Husbandry & Fisheries Department, No.571, 4th Floor, Anna Salai, Nandanam, Chennai – 600 035 and must reach this office not later than 3.00 P.m on 25.08.2026 in a Sealed cover duly SUBSCRIBED TENDER FOR **“OPERATION & MAINTENANCE OF FISH ANGLING FACILITIES AT CHETPET LAKE, CHENNAI -10** Tender received after 3.00 P.m of the same day will be returned to the Tenderer unopened. Tenderers may be present if they so desire at the time of opening tenders.
2. Tenders shall be submitted either by registered post/courier with acknowledgment due or in person. Tenders by telegram or by any other means of communications will not be accepted.
3. Tenders shall be submitted in the enclosed form only, failing which they will not be considered.
4. (a) Tenders by firm shall be in the firm's name signed on behalf of the firm by the person authorized in this behalf. In case of partnership firm, the names of all the partners with their full postal address should be furnished with the tender and if the firm is registered under the Indian Partnership Act of 1931 the registration Number of the firm should also be given. The partner who is signing a tender form should hold a power of Attorney in his favour to act for and on behalf of the partnership of firm. In case of a joint Hindu Family the tender must be signed by the Manager expressly as such manager.
5. (a) The tender amount should be legibly written in INK BOTH IN FIGURES AND WORDS. The amount quoted should be exclusive of all taxes, etc.,

(b) Tenders containing erasures or alterations without proper Attestation/Omissions are liable to be rejected.
6. (a) The Envelope for the Earnest money shall be superscribed with “Earnest Money” and shall contain EMD of Rs.10,000/- by means of DD issued by a nationalized / scheduled bank located in India favoring " The Managing Director, TNFDC Ltd." payable at Chennai to keep the offer open till acceptance/ rejection thereof is communicated by the TNFDC Administration

or till 120 (One hundred and twenty) days from the date of opening the tender whichever is earlier. ***The EMD should be valid for 90 days beyond the validity of the Tender.*** Offers received without earnest money shall be summarily rejected.

- (b) It shall be understood that the tender documents have been sold/issued to the Tenderer and that the tenderer is permitted to tender in consideration of the stipulation on his part that after submission of his tender, will not renege from or modify the terms and conditions thereof in a manner not acceptable to the TNFDC Administration. If the tenderer fail to observe or comply with the said stipulation, the EMD amount shall be liable to be forfeited to the TNFDC.

No interest will be allowed on the Earnest Money Deposit. Tenders will not be considered unless the Earnest Money Deposit, has been submitted in accordance with the stipulations mentioned above.

7. The Earnest Money Deposit deposited by the successful tenderer will be adjusted towards Security Deposit payable by them before entering into acceptance subject to the conditions stipulated above. The earnest Money Deposit of the unsuccessful tenders will be returned /refunded as soon as the tenders have been disposed off.
8. Each tender must be accompanied with the following:-
 - a. The remittance of Earnest Money Deposit.
 - b. In case of a Partnership Firm, the copy of the certificate of registration issued by the Competent Authority.
 - c. The copy of the a power of Attorney of the Managing Partner to sign the Tender document should also be enclosed with the tender
9. Tenders submitted without proper and fully complying with tender requirement will be disqualified and will not be considered.
10. The Successful tenderer shall be required to execute an agreement in the prescribed form without which he will not be considered.
11. (i) The successful tenderer must deposit to the TNFDC Administration in advance at the time of initial award of the contract a sum equivalent to 25% of

the annual contract value as Security deposit/Bank Guarantee valid for 3 years 6 months or maximum years of agreement as the case may be, within 14 days of the date of acceptance and communication of the tender and execute an agreement in the prescribed form

(ii) The successful applicant shall remit security deposit in the form of Demand Draft / Bank Guarantee being 25% of the contract value which will be veils and kept open not only during the contract period of three years but also for a further period of six months beyond the contract period and take up the contract within 14 days of the date of acceptance of tender.

12. If a tenderer whose tender has been accepted and communicated decline or failed to remit the 25% bank Guarantee as referred above and also execute an Agreement in the prescribed form and take up the contract within 14 days from the date of acceptance of tender, the Earnest Money Deposit will be forfeited by the TNFDC administration as ascertained liquidated damages.
13. The contractor or his Agent must be available at the Chetpet Eco Park from 09.00 a.m to 06.00 p.m. or such period as may be specified from time to time by any authorized official of TNFDC.
14. The successful tenderer shall not assign, sublet or transfer the contract either on whole or part. If it is found that the contract has been assigned or sublet or either in part or in full, the TNFDC Administration will terminate the contract without any notice; duly forfeiting the Security as ascertained liquidated damages.
15. No separate communication relating to the tender must be addressed by the tenderer to the Officer or any other person in the TNFDC Administration by all explanatory or qualifying remarks for which as the tenderer may desire to make; the should be recorded in the tender form in the space provided for purpose in the respective paras.
16. Further the TNFDC Administration reserves the right to accept/negotiate with the next second highest tenderer in the event the highest tenderer withdraws the bid or not able to abide by the terms and conditions of the contract.

17. The persons employed by the tenderer should not have any Police records/criminal cases against them. The tenderer should make adequate enquiries about the character and antecedents of the persons whom they are employing. The character and antecedents of persons will be verified by the tenderer before their deployment through local police, collecting proofs of residence, driving license, bank account details, previous work experience and recent photograph and a certification to this effect submitted to this office. The tenderer will also ensure that the personnel deployed are medically fit and will keep in record a certificate of their medical fitness. The tenderer shall withdraw such employees who are not found suitable by the office for any reasons immediately on receipt of such a request.
18. The tenderer will have to bear cost of providing personnel for the work load/ duty hours or weekly off. The said persons engaged by the tenderer shall be the employee of the tenderer and it shall be the duty of the tenderer to pay their salary every month.
19. There is no Master and Servant relationship between the employees of the tenderer and this office and further that the said person of the tenderer shall not claim any absorption in TNFDC or in the Government of India.
20. The tenderer's person shall not claim any benefit/ compensation/ absorption/ regularization of services from/in this office under the provision of Industrial Disputes Act., 1947 or Contract Labor (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970.
21. The tenderer's personnel shall not divulge or disclose to any person, any details of office, operational process, technical know-how, security arrangements and administrative / organizational matters as all are of confidential/secret nature.
22. The tenderer's personnel should be polite, cordial, positive and efficient, while handling the assigned facilities. The tenderer shall be responsible for any act of indiscipline on the part of persons deployed by him. The agency shall be bound to prohibit and prevent any of their employees from being intoxicated while on duty, trespassing or acting in any detrimental or prejudicial to the interest of this office. The decision of the officer in charge upon any matter arising under the clause shall be final and binding on the tenderer.

23. That the persons engaged shall not be below the age of 18 years or above the age of 45 years and they shall not interfere with the duties of the employees of TNFDC.
24. TNFDC may require the tenderer to dismiss or remove from the site of work, any person or persons, employed by the tenderer, who may be incompetent or for his/ her/their misconduct and the tenderer shall forthwith comply with such requirements. The tenderer shall replace immediately any of its personnel, if they are unacceptable to this office because of security risk, incompetence, conflict of interest and breach of confidentiality or improper conduct upon receiving written notice from office.
25. The tenderer has to provide Photo Identity Cards to the persons employed by him/her for carrying out the work. These cards are to be constantly displayed & their loss reported immediately.
26. The transportation, food, medical and other statutory requirements in respect of each personnel of the tenderer shall be the responsibility of the tenderer.
27. The tenderer shall have employer's liability and workers' compensation insurance in respect of the Personnel of the agency and of any sub-contractors, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Applicable law, as well as, with respect to such personnel, any such life, health, accident, travel or other insurance as may be appropriate; and
28. That the tenderer will be wholly and exclusively responsible for payment of wages to the persons engaged by him in compliance of all the statutory obligations under all related legislations as applicable from time to time including Minimum Wages Act, Employees Provident Fund, ESI Act etc. and TNFDC shall not incur any liability for any expenditure whatsoever on the persons employed by the tenderer on account of any obligation.
29. The tenderer shall provide a substitute well in advance if there is any probability of the person leaving the job due to his/her own personal reasons.
30. The tenderer shall be contactable at all times and messages sent by phone /e-mail/ fax / special messenger from this office shall be acknowledged immediately on receipt, on the same day. The tenderer shall strictly observe

the instructions issued by the TNFDC in fulfillment of the contract from time to time.

31. TNFDC shall not be liable for any loss, damage, theft, burglary or robbery of any personal belongings, equipment or vehicles of the personnel of the tenderer.
32. If TNFDC suffers any loss or damage on account of negligence, default or theft on the part of the employees / tenderer, then the tenderer shall be liable to reimburse to this office for the same. The tenderer shall keep this office fully indemnified against any such loss or damage. Any accident/ casualty occurred during the course of working to any staff engaged by the tenderer; the responsibility will remain with the tenderer. For any accident or casualty occurred during the course of working to any staff deployed by the tenderer, the liability that will arise out of the accident will be borne by the tenderer. The responsibility will remain with tenderer and this office will no way be responsible for it or any other clause mentioned above.
33. The successful bidder shall furnish a Security Deposit equivalent to 25% of the contract value by means of demand draft drawn in favour of the Managing Director, TNFDC Ltd. or Fixed Deposit Receipt from a nationalized / commercial bank or Bank Guarantee from a nationalized / commercial bank in an acceptable manner safeguarding the interest of this office in all respects. The security deposit shall remain valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the tenderer.
34. The successful bidder will enter into an agreement with this office on the terms and conditions in a non judicial Rs. 100/- stamp paper. The above stamp paper will be arranged by the bidder for execution of agreement. The agreement will be valid for a period of three years commencing from, and shall continue to be in force in the same manner, unless terminated in writing.
35. The rates quoted by the tenderer shall be on annual basis with an increase at 10% of every year for a period of three years and no request for any change/modification shall be entertained before expiry of three years.
36. The tenderer shall not assign, transfer, pledge or sub contract the performance of services.

37. The agreement can be terminated by either party by giving three months' notice in advance. If the agency fails to give one month's notice in writing for termination of the Agreement.
38. That on the expiry of the agreement as mentioned above, the tenderer should withdraw all its personnel and clear their accounts by paying them all their legal dues. In case of any dispute on account of the termination of employment or non-employment by the personnel of the tenderer, it shall be the entire responsibility of the tenderer to pay and settle the same.
39. That if any amount is found payable by the bidders towards, wages, allowances and statutory dues in respect of personnel or any loss to this office property, the same shall be adjusted from the security deposit of the extent of the amount so determined reserving right to recover the deficit amount through other modes of recovery including the right to terminate the agreement without notice.
40. TNFDC reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever and the decision of the management shall be final and binding on all the bidders.
41. EPF and ESI contribution to be paid for personnel employed by the tenderer it shall be responsibility of tenderer.
42. The employed personnel shall wear a common dress and shall have a badge mentioning their name and cadre. It should be worn by the personnel while on duty.
43. The personnel shall not cook or make noise or use music system inside the Eco Park/Lake view point.
44. In case of dispute arising between the tenderer and staffs of other firms personnel of Chetpet Eco Park, the tenderer shall refer the matter in writing to the Managing Director, TNFDC whose decision in the matter shall be final.
45. The Managing Director, TNFDC as the Competent/Legal authority reserves the right to cancel the lease without assigning any reasons therefore.

46. For breach of any of these conditions the Managing Director, TNFDC will be the legal authority to take penal action as deemed fit.
47. Any money due by the tenderer under the terms of the tender shall be recovered by the appropriate statutory act or any modifications thereof.
48. In case of any dispute, the tenderer will refer the dispute to an Arbitrator in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (Central Act 26 of 1996) and both the parties agree to abide by the decision of the Arbitrator and the place of Arbitration shall be at Chennai.
